CHARLES RIVER WHITELION
RIDE SCHEDULE

SUNDAY, APRIL 1, 11:00 A.M. Meet at Duck Feeding area at intersection of Rts. 128 & 30. Ride north through Waltham, Lexington and return. Distance - short intermediate (approx. 20 miles). Pace - moderate. Expected elapsed time, 2 hours. (See also below.)

SUNDAY, APRIL 1, 1:30 P.M. Meet as above. Ride south through Weston, Wellesley and return by Needham and Newton. Distance (this ride only) - short intermediate (approx. 20 miles). Pace - moderate. Ride both for long intermediate (approx. 40 miles). Expected elapsed time, 2 hours; for both rides, $1\frac{1}{2}$ hours. Leader: Ed Trumbull, 332-8546.

SATURDAY, APRIL 7, 10:00 A.M. Meet next to Hatch Memorial Shell Charles River Basin, Boston. Ride west to the Larz Anderson Antique Auto Museum and Arnold Arboretum. Bring a lunch. There will be a planned stop for beverage. Distance - short intermediate. Pace - leisurely. Expected elapsed time, 5 hours. This is another of the Metro series. SUNDAY, APRIL 15, 1:00 P.M. Meet at Sears Roebuck parking lot at 1815 Massachusetts Avenue, Cambridge (next to Harvard Trust Co. near Porter Square). This will be a leisurely ride of 10-15 miles to the Beaver Brook Reservation, Belmont and return by 4:00 P.M. This is the only ride scheduled for this date as it will follow the skills course conducted by Dave Cary.
